## Special Constables.

## Orders for Patrols.

---

1. To patrol all roads on the Constables' beat and carefully and constantly inspect telegraph wires and posts, buttresses, arches and roadways of all bridges, and all culverts under roadways and railways and immediately report to the nearest Kent County Constable any damage they may discover, or any other suspicious circumstances.
2. To take notice of all passers by and stop and question all who look like foreigners or suspicious persons and if the constable suspects them to be Germans or Austrians, to demand their permits and unless produced to detain them until they can hand them over to the nearest Kent County Constable.
3. Every patrol to carry a truncheon, or stick, and a whistle, which he will hand over to the relieving patrol. No unnecessary violence to be used, and no whistle on any account to be blown except when necessary to call for assistance.
4. Any constable in the parish on hearing a warning whistle to proceed to the spot immediately to render assistance, in no other case should a constable leave his beat until properly relieved.
5. All constables to be invited to use bicycles if they possess them.
6. No person to be allowed to loiter on or near any bridge or culvert.
